FROM OUR PARISH PRIEST

Dear Friends,

We warmly welcome Father Merv Duffy SM who is celebrating the 8.00am and 9.30am Masses this morning in my absence.

In exactly two weeks time, on Sunday *24th February* I will be celebrating the *Fortieth Anniversary* of my *Ordination to the Priesthood*. I want to celebrate that simply with you as a Parish Family just at the *9.30 am Mass on Sunday 24th February 2019* followed by a *Shared Parish Morning Tea* which I invite you to come to and bring some finger food to share. God's goodness and mercy are what I want to remember that day and I ask your prayers for me. This week I am away on Retreat, and then for ten days before the anniversary weekend I will be spending time with my family some of whom will be joining me in Auckland for that weekend.

I want to recommend a good solid Lenten exercise to you: *The Season of Lent* begins with *Ash Wednesday on March 06th*, and that day we will have *Mass with the Blessing and Imposition of Ashes at 6.00am and 9.15am*, and it is our turn this year to host *the Joint Anglican/Catholic Liturgy for the Blessing and Imposition of Ashes at 7.00pm*. But on the *six Fridays of Lent* (beginning Friday 8th March and concluding Friday 12th April) I would like to invite you all to *simple Stations of the Cross at 7.00pm*, followed by Six Talks I would like to give from *7.30pm - 8.15pm* on "*Understanding the Profession of Faith - Making Sense of The Creed*". I really see this as food for the soul as well as the mind and I think it would be a really good Lenten exercise to commit to for the six weeks of Lent.
